CONDITIONS

1. Entrance fees must be **paid at the time of entry**. Entries to be made through the Sorrento Golf Club, Langford Road, Sorrento 3943.
2. Any Invited Club will be entitled to enter ONE TEAM of three players. **Entries close Tuesday 2nd April or when capacity field is reached**. Please ensure all names are listed on the entry form or sent through to club@sorrentogolf.com.au by this time. In the event of a team member being unable to play, another member of the Club may be substituted.
3. The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by R&A, together with such local rules as are in force on the course over which the competition rounds are being played. If a dispute arises it shall be decided by the Match Committee whose decision shall be final. Provided however that the Committee if in doubt shall have the right to refer any such dispute to Golf Australia whose decision shall be final.
4. In every event competitors will be drawn against each other for the day in such a manner as the Match Committee may arrange, and the Match Committee, or such person as they may authorise, shall have the power to select a marker for any competitor whose fellow competitor is not at the first tee when called upon at the time appointed to start.
5. The Match Committee to make all arrangements, and to have full power to alter or make any variation in the Condition of the Programme should they deem it desirable.
6. The Match Committee or such person as the Match Committee may authorise, may, in the event of bad weather, or for any reason, shorten the contest.
7. In the event of a tie in Events 1 & 2, the winner will be decided on a count back. Trophies will be presented to the three members of the winning team.
8. Trophy to be held by winning Club for one year. The Club's name will be engraved on the Salver.
9. Medical certificate required for the use of a golf cart, unless over the age of 70.
10. All scoring will be via MiScore
