be no higher than 31.6 at time of entry
- A club may enter a team of four (4)
players and substitutes will be accepted
- Entry fee is \$75pp/\$300 per team
and includes all concurrent events and lunch
- Neat golfing attire is acceptable
in the Clubhouse

Entries should be made by the club, who should forward names of competitors, handicaps and entrance fee by **Monday 3 November 2025**.

The National Goblet may be held for one year by the club returning the highest aggregate score.

Trophies will also be awarded to the individual players with the highest Stableford score in Silver and Bronze divisions.

The National Goblet – Conditions of Entry

- Entrance fees (\$300) must be paid at time of entry.
- The event will be held on the Cape Schanck Gunnamatta Course from the burgundy tees and is open to female amateurs who are members of a golf club affiliated with Golf Australia and who have an official G.A handicap which does not exceed 31.6. The National Golf Club shall have the right to refuse any entry.
- The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, together with the Club's local rules. If any dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Committee, whose decision shall be final. In addition, all players are required to adhere to Golf Australia's Code of Conduct for the duration of the event.
- Should it be necessary to limit the field, a ballot will be decided on receipt of entry, and in this instance, only one team per club will be permitted entry.
- The Committee reserves the right to make any variation in the conditions should it be deemed necessary.
- The Committee may, in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either cancel the event, shorten the event or fix another day for play.
- In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided by Golf Australia count back system.
- The draw will be emailed to all participating clubs on Thursday 6 November 2025.
- During the event, players may have their photo taken which may be displayed on the website and other promotional material. Any player not wishing to have their photo displayed or their details retained should inform The National Golf Club.
- Neat golf attire (NO denim, NO cargo pants/shorts) and non-metal spikes are compulsory on course. Golf or neat casual attire is required in the Clubhouse. Players should refer to The National Golf Club's dress regulations document which can be found on the club website.
- Motorised Carts: All play will be in carts and carts are included in the cost of the day. Staff will lead groups out to their tee in preparation for the shotgun start.
