Conditions of Entry and Competition 2026

1. History

This competition is sponsored by MKR Jewellery Design, Rosebud. The inaugural event was held in 2014.

2. Competition

This competition is a Ladies individual and aggregate team Stableford event. In the event of a tie, a countback will be used to determine the winner.

3. Eligibility

Open to any female amateur player holding an official Golf Australia handicap. The maximum daily handicap for the day will be 45. (Players with a higher handicap will be playing off 45)

4. Entries

- a. The entry fee is \$150 per pair
- b. Cancellations will not be refunded. Players may be substituted.
- c. If the number of entries exceeds the maximum field capacity, entries will be returned and refunded. Unsuccessful entries will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals occur.

5. Conditions of Competition

- a. The competition shall be played in accordance with the rules of golf as adopted by The Royal and Ancient Club of St Andrews, together with any local rules that are in force on the course. If any dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the CPC Match Committee.
- b. Players are required to comply with the dress standards of the host club.
- c. Ties – there will be a count back in accordance with the R & A rules.
- d. Players may use a distance measuring device to measure distance only.

6. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to:

- * The overall **Single Stableford Winner** will be the recipient of the diamond from MKR Jewellery Design and will be the only winner to receive a diamond as a prize.
- * **Single Stableford Runner Up**
- * **Best Aggregate Score**
This will be the pair that return the highest aggregate pairs score.
- * **Runner Up Aggregate Score**
This will be the pair that return the second highest aggregate pairs score.
- * **Longest Drive** on 10th Hole (one for members and one for guests)
- * **NTP's** on all Par 3's for members and guests.

7. Registration

Players are asked to arrive at the Course at least 45 minutes prior to the stipulated tee time.
